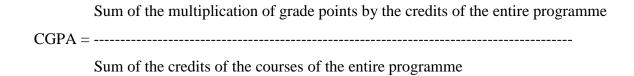

- **c.** A candidate who has passed all the Part-II or Part-III subjects examination of the UG programmes and secured a CGPA of 6 to 7.5 and equivalent grades "A" or "A++" or "A++" will be declared to have passed that parts in "**First Class**".
- **d.** A candidate who has passed all the Part-I or Part-II or Part-III subjects examination of the UG programmes and secured a CGPA of 5.5 to 6 and equivalent grades "B" or "B+" will be declared to have passed that parts in "**Second Class**".

- **e.** A candidate who has passed all the Part-II or Part-III subject examinations of the UG programmes and secured a CGPA of 4.5 to 5 and equivalent grades "C" or "C+" will be declared to have passed that parts in "**Third Class**".
- **f.** There will be no classifications of final results, therefore, award of class for Part IV and Part V, however, those parts will be awarded with final grades in the end semester statements of marks and in the consolidated statement of marks.
