Components of Internal Marks for Theory Courses – General Track

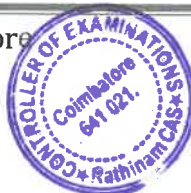
1. Test I – 10 Marks

7. Quiz – 5 Marks

Components of Internal Marks for Theory Courses – Skill Track

1. Test I – 10 Marks
2. Test II – 10 Marks
3. Attendance – 10 Marks
4. Skill Assessment (Redemption ratio) – 20 Marks

Description of the Components:

1. **Test I** – A centralized examination will be conducted for 100 marks with first 3 Units (1st, 2nd & 3rd Units) of the syllabus. Question papers will be prepared by the Office of the Controller of Examinations using CoE software.
2. **Test II** – A centralized examination will be conducted for 100 marks with Last 2 Units (4th & 5th Units) of the syllabus. Question papers will be prepared by the Office of the Controller of Examinations using CoE software.



3. **Attendance** – Attendance will be downloaded from the Learning Management System and following are the allocation of marks.

4. **Assignment** – A minimum of two topics will be given by the subject handling faculty and the same will be posted in the Learning Management System. Topics may be given from the subject or General topic related to the subject.
5. **Seminar** – A minimum of one seminar must be completed by the student. Unique topics will be given by the subject handling faculty (Same assignment topic may be given as seminar topic).
6. **Technical / Creative** – Student may attend a seminar or conference (or) secure a prize in a Technical Event organized by academic & research institutions. The certificate of the same shall be submitted to obtain the marks. Otherwise, A creative work related to the subject may be carried out by the student (or) may undergo an internship and submit a report to avail the marks.
7. **Quiz** – Online quiz shall be given at the end of every class through Learning Management System. The average of the daily quiz will be provided as marks.
8. **Skill Assessment (Redemption ratio)** – Student can redeem the points secured from the skill assessment portal as per the following schedule:
- First Redemption
 - Students can redeem skill points for up to 10 internal marks per subject (across applicable subjects) based on the announced redemption ratio.
 - Second Redemption
 - Students can redeem skill points for the remaining 10 internal marks per subject based on the announced redemption ratio.

Components of Internal Marks for Practical Courses

1. Test I – 10 Marks (Conducted within 40th working day)
2. Observation Note Book – 10 Marks
3. Attendance – 10 Marks
4. Model practical examination / Skill Assessment (redeem) – 20

Components of Internal Marks for Project Viva – Voce Courses

1. Review I – 10 Marks (Conducted on 20th working day)
2. Review II – 10 Marks (Conducted on 40th working day)
3. Review III – 10 Marks (Conducted on 60th working day)
4. Publication – 20 Marks (To be published on 60th working day)

Important Note:

Final internal mark should be given for out of 50 marks. The system will convert the marks, according to the actual internal marks.
